(TRAILS), 2023

About the Conference

The international conference is titled 1st Trisakti International Conference on Law for Social Welfare (TRAILS 2023) and carries the theme "The Role of Law in the Digital Era to Achieve Social Welfare". TRAILS 2023, which will be held on September 25th and 26th, 2023 in Jakarta, Indonesia, is organized by the Faculty of Law, Universitas Trisakti. TRAILS 2023 will provide an incredible opportunity for lecturers, researchers, delegates, and scholars to interact with one another and share their experiences and knowledge of the law and social sciences.

Adam Smith viewed law as a force that can be shaped and manipulated to change human behavior and achieve development. According to Roscoe Pound, the proper goal of a legal system is to satisfy demands, desires, and claims. "Interests" are referred to by demands, desires, and claims. De facto interests are interests. In a society where applied sciences are used to solve individual and social problems, law balances competing interests.

Many legal issues have arisen as a result of the current digital era due to the rapid development of technology, and the role of law is increasingly facing extraordinary challenges. The digital era is defined by technology that accelerates and broadens knowledge turnover in the economy and society. Faster knowledge turnover is advantageous because new knowledge is generated more frequently, allowing for adaptation to changing environmental conditions.

The digital era is characterized by the widespread dissemination, access, and sharing of information via electronic means. Information literacy and lifelong learning have a strategic relationship to the success of individuals, organizations, and institutions in the global information society, which will improve quality of life and contribute to social welfare. Information literacy requires users to be able to access and create information using information and communication technologies and their applications.

The promotion of social welfare is one of many functions of the

law. The term "social welfare" refers to a society's governmental and non-governmental efforts to help its members function more effectively as individuals and as members of organized social structures. Social welfare is the state or condition of a society's well-being when social problems are managed, human needs are met, and social opportunities are maximized. A social problem is any difficulty or misbehavior of a relatively large number of people that must be removed or corrected because the problem has negative consequences for a large number of people. Approximately 10% of the world's population currently lives on the equivalent of \$1.90 per day.

Social welfare is important because many people live below the global poverty line, the majority of whom live in Sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia, and many of whom are children. Lack of necessities, discrimination and exclusion, poor governance, conflict and crisis, a lack of access to social services, climate change, and the poverty cycle itself are the root causes. In the broadest sense, the law is examined as a legal construct—looking at ways to exacerbate poverty or enshrine a human right not to be poor, to establish specific rights entitlements for poverty reduction.

According to the above description, there is an urgent need to discuss a broader perspective on the role of law and social sciences in the current digital era to address such issues.

Goals and Benefit

The goals of TRAILS 2023 are as follows: first, to actively participate in international legal development to create social welfare; second, to strengthen the role of higher education institutions in the global era to create social welfare; and third, to increase webometrics and popularity in the digital world to create social welfare.

Through presentation, discussion, and scientific paper publication, TRAILS 2023 is expected to benefit stakeholders such as the government, academia, researchers, and the community by sharing knowledge and input on various study results on the role of law in this digital era for social welfare.
